Grooming Agreement

For the safety of all our guests, all dogs must have current vaccinations. By signing this agreement, owners verify their pets are current on the following vaccinations: **Rabies**

Proof of Vaccination Required

Owners MUST inform Beacon Paws LLC if your pet(s) bite(s), has bitten or is aggressive to people, other pets or specific grooming procedures. Beacon Paws LLC reserves the right to refuse or stop service for your pet at any time before or after the grooming process. If your dog should bite, the owner agrees to be responsible for any or all related medical bills, recovery cost, and loss of income and equipment.

Grooming procedures can sometimes be stressful, especially for senior pets or puppies or pets with health problems, and can expose hidden medical problems or aggravate a current one during or after the groom. Aggravation caused to a medical problem, although very rare, can lead to death. Beacon Paws LLC is not responsible for any injuries or death cause by these medical conditions. Beacon Paws LLC will make the grooming experience as relaxing as possible for your pet and will watch for any signs of discomfort. If at any time your pet should need immediate veterinary treatment during their stay we will do our best to contact you first, and then take your pet to the closest veterinarian for immediate treatment. By signing this agreement Beacon Paws LLC has permission to obtain immediate veterinary treatment for your pet if deemed necessary.

Pets with matted coats need extra attention and an extra fee will be charged for removal. Mats left in a pet's coat only grow tighter, and can strangle a pet's skin or eventually tear it open. Matted coats will be shaved. Removing a matted coat included a risk of nicks, cuts or abrasions due to warts, moles and skin folds trapped in the mats. Matting can also trap moisture and urine close to the skin allowing mold, fungus, or bacteria to grow, causing skin irritations that exist prior to the grooming procedure. The after affects to mat removal can include, skin redness, itchiness, self-inflicted irritation or abrasions. Prevention is the best defense against matting by grooming your pet regularly.

There is always the possibility that an accident could occur. Grooming equipment is sharp, even though we use extreme caution and care in all situations. Problems that can occur include cuts, nicks, scratches and quicking of nails ect. in most cases this happens when your pet is wiggling or moving around. We will make every effort to insure your pet is groomed as safely as possible.

If fleas are found on your dog we must treat the dog with a flea and tick bath or dip. This procedure will be done at the owner's expense.

All pets must be picked up by closing at the end of the day. By signing this agreement I understand that I will be charged a boarding fee for any dog left overnight. All charges incurred by owner shall be payable upon pick-up of pet. Beacon Paws LLC in hereby granted a lien on the pet for any and all unpaid charges. If the pet is not picked up within three calendar days after the pet was due to be picked up, the pet shall be considered abandoned.

By signing this contract you (or your agent) agree to hold Beacon Paws LLC its owners, operators, employees, officers, and directors harmless from all damages or claims arising from any condition of the undersigned pet (s), either known or unknown by Beacon Paws LLC. It is also understood that the terms of this agreement can be changed at any time, without notice, and will overwrite any and all prior signed contact or releases.

I have read and agree to the policies of Beacon Paws LLC, and I am aware that this agreement will be kept on file and will apply to all future visits.
